Masters display Olympic spirit, again and again

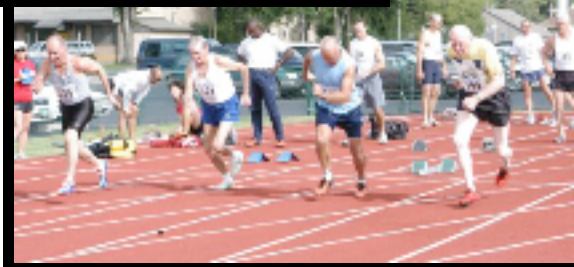

SUBMASTERS: 19 thru 29, 30-34, 35-39.

Awards: 6 places in each event receive medals. Mid-America Region medals for 1st thru 3rd, and RMMG Medals 4th thru 6th.

Rules: Standard USA Track & Field rules. Electronic timing. USAT&F registration is required and will be available at meet.

Entries: If received by Wednesday prior to meet will be published in the program and be in the drawing for gifts at the meet.
